ABOUT THE FUND



Investors aiming to benefit from the strategic fund positioning based on the business cycle phase. It has 4 phases: Recovery, recession, slump, expansion, each phase offers unique Opportunities and Rewards

- Monitor Macro Indicators & identify Business Cycle Opportunity.
- Identify themes / sectors based on business cycle opportunity.
- Identify stocks based on finalised themes / sectors.
- A periodic assessment of the macro-economic environment and the subsequent investment approach is conducted, based on which the portfolio may be reallocated.

PORTFOLIO POSITIONING


- This is a fund which follows the business cycle approach of investing by identifying economic trends and investing in the sectors and stocks that are likely to outperform at any given stage of the business cycle.
- The key overweight positions are in Consumer Staples (expect rebound in volume growth and worst of margins being behind) and Pharmaceuticals & Healthcare (healthcare expenditure expected to remain healthy and valuations have become attractive).
- The key underweight position is in Materials where there are pockets of overvaluation. We are also underweighting on discretionary consumption where we believe that competitive intensity is high.
- The fund has 77% investment in large cap, 11.5% in mid cap and 7.5% in small cap stocks.

CURRENT MARKET CAP (% of Net Assets)






