ABOUT THE FUND

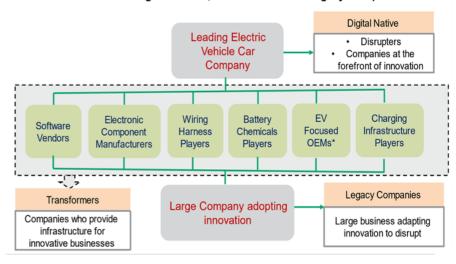
- Baroda BNP Paribas Innovation Fund aims to invest in companies that benefit from Innovation

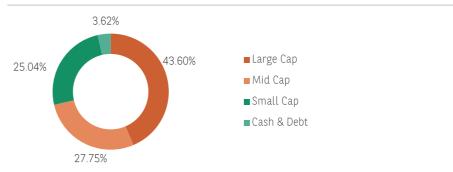
- Sector agnostic fund and stock selection led themes- innovator, enablers and legacy transformation cos.

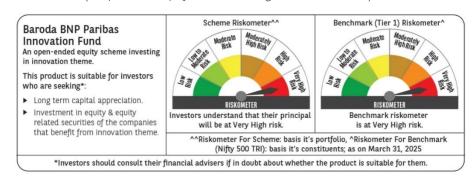
