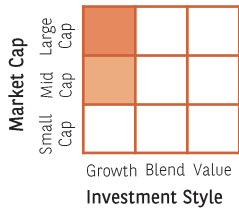

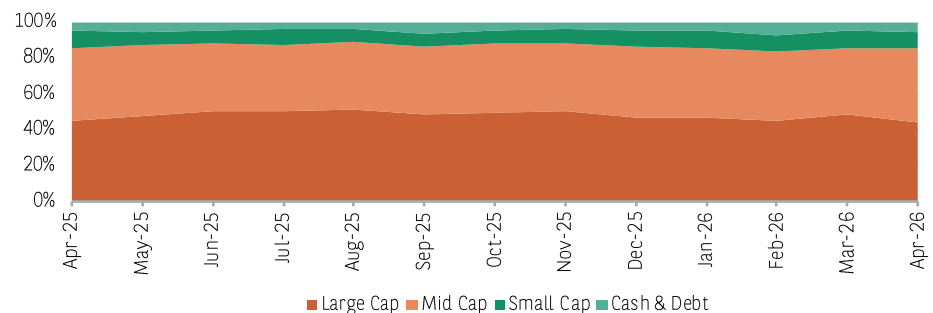
## ABOUT THE FUND

Baroda BNP Paribas Large & Mid Cap Fund invest a minimum of 35% in large cap companies and also invest minimum of 35% in mid cap companies respectively. It is an open-ended equity fund focused on creating long term capital growth by investing in a mix of Large & Mid cap stocks. It aims to have a diversified portfolio of high quality stocks at reasonable prices where the fund would invest a minimum of 35% in Large & Mid cap stocks each with a maximum cap of 65%. The fund can invest up to 30% of the corpus in other equities including small cap stocks (0-30%), debt & money market instruments (0-20%), InVITs (0-10%). Due to their exposure in both large and mid-cap stocks, these funds are positioned on a higher risk return trade-off as compared to a pure large cap fund, but less risky than a multi-cap fund.

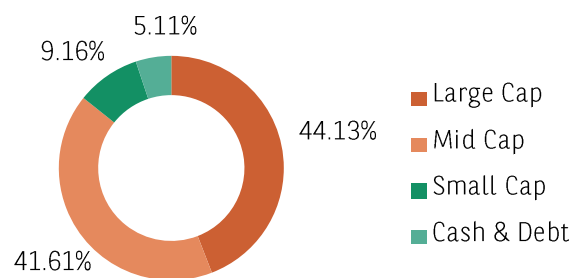
## PORTFOLIO POSITIONING

- The NIFTY Large Midcap 250 TRI index was up ~1105bps for the month as equity markets rebounded post the March correction.
- Compared to last month, we have increased magnitude of OW on Industrials (+260bps MoM) and Materials (+60bps) and cut magnitude of UW on Health Care (+50bps). As against, we have turned UW on Consumer Discretionary (-330bps MoM), increased UW on Financials (-140bps) and trimmed OW position on Information Technology (-80bps).
- Key overweight positions are Materials and Industrials, while key underweight positions are Energy, Utilities and Consumer Staples.
- We have increased SMID exposure to 50.8% from 47.4% a month ago, whereas cut Large Cap exposure to 44.1% from 48.8% a month ago.
- We have increased Cash position to 5.1% from 3.8% a month ago.

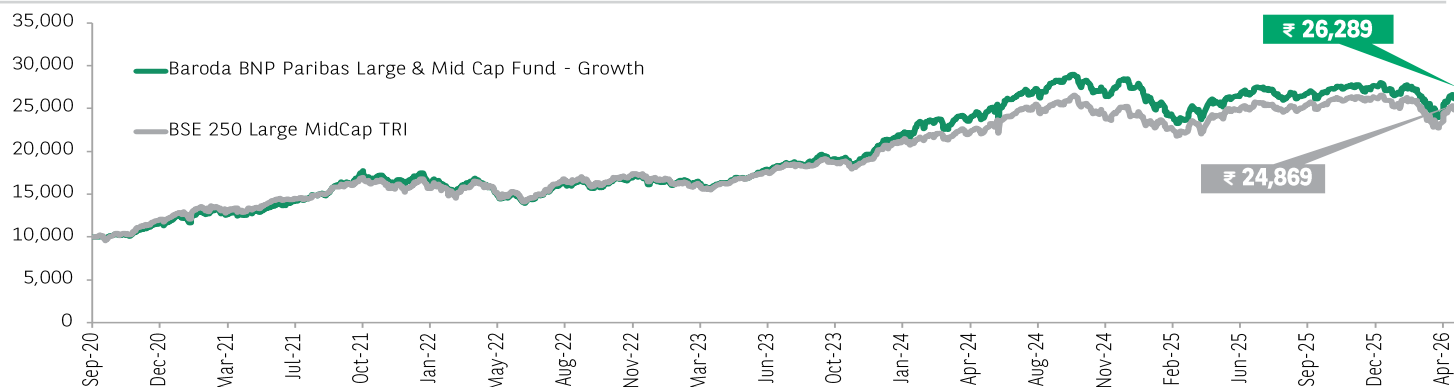
## HISTORIC MARKET CAP (% of Net Assets)

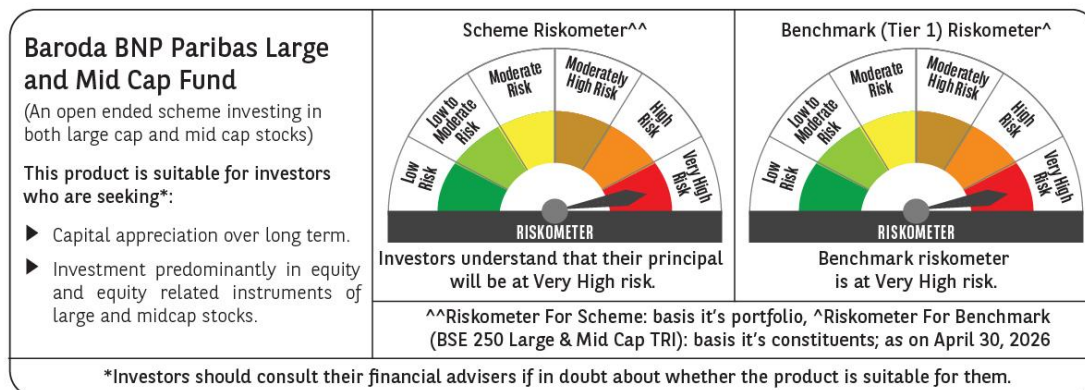
