

ABOUT THE FUND


- Baroda BNP Paribas Low Duration Fund invests in fixed income instruments such that Macaulay duration of scheme is between 6 -
- The short maturity profile of the fund helps to reduce the sensitivity of the portfolio to changing interest rate scenarios
- The scheme aims to invest in a prudent mix of debt securities, money market instruments and government securities to generate capital appreciation. The portfolio construction process follows a stringent internal credit policy framework with the endeavor to invest in papers of high credit quality. Thus it aims to offer short maturity, high liquidity and moderate credit risk.
- The scheme is suitable for investors with investment horizon of 6-12 months to park their idle or surplus money.


PORTFOLIO POSITIONING

- While the RBI has continued to conduct VRRR auctions, the weighted average overnight Rates have continued to trade below repo rate due to surplus liquidity
- We expect liquidity to remain surplus even after maturity of \$5Bn Fx Buy/sell swap and the indirect tax and GST outflow
- Neutral Stance by RBI indicates the market that the operational overnight rate may remain closer to repo rate.
- Money market yield remained flat across the curve
- To benefit from a liquidity surplus and potential rate cutting scenario, the scheme is maintaining the Macaulay duration near to the higher end of the range mandated by the regulator and may continue to be invested in that direction
- To achieve the same, we remain invested in small amount in AAA rated PTCs to enhance the YTMs and benefit from portfolio diversification


RATING ALLOCATION TREND (% of Net Assets)

The weight of each cash flow is determined by dividing the present value of the cash flow by the price. Factors like a bond's price, maturity, coupon, yield to maturity among others impact the calculation of Macaulay duration.

* Concept of Macaulay duration - The Macaulay Duration is a measure of a bond's sensitivity to interest rate changes. It is expressed in annual terms. It is the weighted average term to maturity of the cash flows from a bond. The weight of each cash flow is determined by dividing the present value of the cash flow by the price. Factors like a bond's price, maturity, coupon, yield to maturity among others impact the calculation of Macaulay duration. The Macaulay duration can be viewed as the economic balance point of a group of cash flows. Another way to interpret the statistic is that it is the weighted average number of years an investor must maintain a position in the bond until the present value of the bond's cash flows equals the amount paid for the bond. As it provides a way to estimate the effect of certain market changes on a bond's price, the investor can choose an investment that will better meet his future cash needs.
